



STEP 2 Open The Main Frame




STEP 3
The Front Wheels Assembly

Insert the wheel into the main frame(fig 3, 3-1), make sure the hexagon head insert into the plastic socket(fig 3-2, 3-3), the same steps to assemble the other front wheel(fig 3-4).







STEP 4 Handle Bars Assembly






STEP 5 Handgrips Assembly






STEP 6

Pull out the seat stick, then hang the storage bag on it (7, 7-1)




STEP 8

Press the spring button, then insert it into the main frame(fig 8, 8-1), the same steps to assemble the other handle(fig 8-2).






STEP 9 Organize Brake Cables

ONE-HAND FOLDING

Fold the walker by pulling up the strap of seat(fig 12. 12-1). Then push the upper part backward(fig 12-2), the walker will be folded flat easily.







THE FOOT LIFT

HOW TO ADJUST BRAKES





Adjust Rear Brake Position

Tools: Plier or 10mm wrench (fig 1).
Use plier(or 10mm wrench) to turn M6 nut counter-clockwise(fig 2-3). And brake will be closer to wheel(fig 4). Then squeeze handbrake, if it doesn't work, repeat the steps until rear brake can engage wheel.

A WARNINGS

To ensure your safety in using ELENKER Rollator Walker, all the following instructions must be followed

- \triangle The maximum load of the walker is 300lbs.
- DO NOT use walker, if there is apparent damage or if any parts are missing.
- Ensure that brakes, height adjustment bolts or any other moving parts are in good condition and check all screws and fasteners, and retighten if necessary.
- DO NOT use on stairs, escalators, moving sidewalks, or go up or down inclines greater than 15% or diagonally across inclines greater than 5%.
- Be careful to avoid pinching your fingers while raising and lowering the handle bar and opening and closing the rollator walker frame.
