

1x Cup holder



## STEP 2 Rear Wheels Assembly

Align the hole of rear leg tube with the bottom hole of main frame (fig 2), then insert the bolt and use open end wrench to secure it with nut (fig 2-1, 2-2). Align the hole of shock absorber with the upper hole of main frame, then secure it with wire lock pin (fig 2-3, 2-4, 2-5, 2-6).

The same steps to assemble right rear leg, there are labels on tubes and main frame "L1-L1, R1-R1".






## STEP 3 **Handle Bar Tubes Assembly**


Insert the safety belt and the handle bar tube into the main frame (fig 3, 3-1), then secure it with knob (fig 3-2, 3-3).

The same steps to assemble right handle bar tube, there are labels on tubes


STEP 5 Cane Holder Assembly

cane holder knob of cane holder "8" shape hook and loop strap





Hook and Loop Straps of Brake Cables Assembly






## **One-hand Folding**




## **Handbrakes Operation**

### **HOW TO ADJUST BRAKES**



#### **Adjust Rear Brake Position**

Tools: Plier or 10mm wrench (fig 1).
Use plier (or 10mm wrench) to turn M6 nut counter-clockwise(fig 2-3). And brake will be closer to wheel(fig 4). Then squeeze handbrake, if it doesn't work, repeat the steps until rear brake can engage wheel.

# **A** WARNINGS

To ensure your safety in using ELENKER Rollator Walker, all the following instructions must be followed



The maximum load of the walker is 300lbs.



DO NOT use walker, if there is apparent damage or if any parts are missing.



Ensure that brakes, height adjustment bolts or any other moving parts are in good condition and check all screws and fasteners, and retighten if necessary.



DO NOT use on stairs, escalators, moving sidewalks, or go up or down inclines greater than 15% or diagonally across inclines greater than 5%.



Be careful to avoid pinching your fingers while raising and lowering the handle bar and opening and closing the rollator walker frame.
