SET-UP INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1



Accessories



1x Cane holder



1x Cup holder



1x Open ends hook and loop strap to secure the upper part of cane



2x Hook and loop straps for brake cables



2x Bolts Washers and Small Nuts(for sit-tostand handle bars)



2x Bolts and Big Nuts(for handle bars)

STEP 2 Seat Assembly


Place the seat on the main frame with seat clip, there are two anti-slip stoppers to prevent the seat sliding, please make sure the clips are on the outside of the anti-slip stoppers(fig 2, 2-1, 2-2).





STEP 3 Front Wheels Assembly

Press spring button of wheel's leg, then insert it into the main frame(fig 3,3-1). The same steps to assemble right front wheel's leg(there are labels on legs and the main frame "L1-L1 R1-R1")(fig 3-2).



STEP 4 Rear Wheels Assembly

Press spring button of wheel's leg, then insert it into the main frame(fig 4,4-1). The same step to assemble right rear wheel's leg(there are labels on legs and the main frame "L2-L2 R2-R2")(fig 4-2).



STEP 5 Handle Bar Assembly

Insert the handle bar tube into the main frame(fig 5), then secure it with bolt and big nut(fig 5-1 5-2). The same step to assemble right handle bar tube (there are labels on tubes and the main frame "L3-L3 R3-R3")(fig 5-3).



STEP 6 The Handgrip Assembly

Insert the handgrip tube into the armrest pad tube(fig 6), adjust length and angle to fit your forearm, then secure it by closing the handgrip clamp lever (fig 6-1, 6-2).





STEP 10
Cane/Umbrella Holder Assembly

Insert cane holder into cane holder knob (cane holder knob is on the right leg tube)(fig 10, 10-1). Then affix the "8" shpae hook and loop strap for securing the upper part of cane(fig 10-2).



STEP 11 Cup Holder Assembly

There is a cup knob on the handle bar(fig 11), insert cup holder into cup knob (fig 11-1) .







HOW TO ADJUST BRAKES

There are two ways to fix it. A: Adjust the screw housing.




- 2. The rear brake cannot engage rear wheel when pressing the handgrip down. (fig 3);
- 3. One hand hold the screw holder, and turn the screw housing left or right (fig 4,5) until rear brake can engage the rear wheel (fig 6).





B: If method one doesn't work, please tighten the brake cable.



- 2. Loosen the screw, the spring will become loose, and the rear brake will loosen:
- 3. Use pliers to pull the brake cable while bringing the rear brake close to the wheel, then tighten the screw;
- 4. Put the handbrake to its original position, the wheel should be able to roll. Press the handbrake down or squeeze the handbrake, and the rear brake should come close to the wheel, indicating a successful adjustment.

A WARNINGS

To ensure your safety in using ELENKER Rollator Walker, all the following instructions must be followed.

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The maximum load of the walker is 500lbs.

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DO NOT use walker, if there is apparent damage or if any parts are missing.

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Ensure that brakes, height adjustment bolts or any other moving parts are in good condition and check all screws and fasteners, and retighten if necessary.

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DO NOT use on stairs, escalators, moving sidewalks, or go up or down inclines greater than 15% or diagonally across inclines greater than 5%.

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Be careful to avoid pinching your fingers while raising and lowering the handle bar and opening and closing the rollator walker frame.

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The rollator walker is intended to provide additional help and support, but is not a substitute for medical treatment or rehabilitation. Please use it correctly under the guidance of professionals, and keep the accessories properly to avoid misuse or damage.
